The International Biomedical Neonatal and Pediatric Transport Conference accepts abstracts related to any aspect of neonatal and/or pediatric transport care.

- Presenters of accepted abstracts should notify Caroline Taggart at ctaggart@int-bio.com as soon as possible if they must cancel their presentation.
- Abstracts will be accepted for poster presentations. Poster presenters may be given the opportunity to discuss their abstracts in a brief oral presentation (5 minutes).
- The International Biomedical Neonatal and Pediatric Transport Conference will consider original research, quality improvement initiatives and/or case reports. Priority will be given to submissions that feature new findings that may lead to changes in practice and improvements in patient care.
- Awards are available for the best abstracts presented during the program.
- Submission will not preclude future submission for journal publication, nor does prior
 publication disqualify submission to this poster session. Priority may be given to papers not
 previously published or presented.

FAQ

- 1. What size should the presentation poster be?
 - Must fit on one side of a 40x 60 Presentation board that will accommodate 2 posters, one on each side. You can bring your poster in a tube with you to the conference or ship it ahead of time. Please email ctaggart@int-bio.com if you plan to ship in advance.
- 2. How many posters will be accepted?
 - No more than 6
- 3. How long will I be presenting?
 - Each person 5 minutes for the presentation that is 30 minutes without questions
 - Presenters should bring handouts and business cards.
- 4. What are the awards?
 - Free tuition to the next year's conference for two (2) members of the team
 - Recognition from podium for all presenters
 - Judging: each attendee gets one vote rating presentations from 1 to 6. Or the total number of posters, the highest total wins.

Tips for Poster Presentations

- Easy to read
- Adequate information without verbal presentation
- Handouts
 - o Helpful
 - Provided additional information that clarified/answered questions
- Contact information for author/presenter
